## MONDAY - SEEDS

### Reading

The Tiny Seed

### Letters & Sounds

Use your seed journal and draw daily what your seed does!

### Math

Seed Sorting – Sort your seeds by the different kinds

### Fine Motor

Cutting the tissue paper with your scissors – remember thumbs up!!

### Art or Sensory

The Tiny Seed – Take the picture and cut the tissue paper and glue on the flower

### Stem/Science

Using the seed house, put your seed and cotton balls in, put a few drops of water and close. Hang in the window and check on daily.

## TUESDAY - SEEDS

### Reading

The Bad Seed

### Letters & Sounds

Seed Names – Take the sunflower seeds and glue them along your name

### Math

How many seeds? Place the number of seed in the number on the box.

### Fine Motor

Cutting your paper plate around the edge with your scissors.

### Art or Sensory

Make a sunflower with paper plate and color it yellow. Glue seeds the in the middle. Cut around the edges to make the pedals.

### Stem –

Plant a sunflower seed outside and watch through the summer!

## WEDNESDAY - Seeds

### Gross Motor

Pretend to be a seed in the ground. Start to sprout and grow into a flower!

### Letters & Sounds

Gel Bags

Practice the letter Ss for Seed!

### Cooking

Make RAINBOW TOAST!! – Take milk and add food coloring. Use a paint brush and paint your bread. Then toast! You can add butter and cinnamon sugar too!

### Reading

Planting a Rainbow

### Art or Sensory

Use the coffee filter and color with marker. Spray with water and let dry.

### Community–

Find a food you eat that has a seed and bring it to Zoom!

## THURSDAY - SEEDS

<b>Reading</b>	<b>Colors –</b>  On your walk find different colors of plants. See if you can find the colors of the rainbow!	<b>Math</b>  On your walk find plants/flowers that you can measure with a ruler and see how tall they are!
<b>Fine Motor</b>  Cut apart the sides of the paper and sort the seeds. Glue them in the right spot!	<b>Art/Name</b>  Use your nature walk book to glue or draw what you saw on your walk	<b>Gross Motor</b>  Go on a nature walk. Collect or draw any seeds you see!

## FRIDAY - SEEDS

<b>Reading</b>  IF you plant a seed of kindness	<b>Letters &amp; Sounds</b>  Practice the letter Ss on your gel bag!	<b>Math</b>  Seed numbers on the flowers – Place the number of beads (seeds on each flower by going up the stem)
<b>Community</b>  How could you plant a seed of kindness? Talk to a parent and tell them and do it 😊	<b>Art or Sensory</b>  Use the juice lid and the seeds and glue them on. Use the string to make a necklace!	<b>Stem –</b>  Seed Balls – Use old paper, tear it up, soak in water, press out extra water in strainer, mix with seeds and let dry.
